

Beginning Sept. 15th you need to be aware that if you make a last minute payment online to pay a bill that is due today, that payment could come out of your bank account the same day. In the past, the earliest the payment would have come out of your bank account would have been tomorrow. This could occur for any bills where you use your routing number and account number to pay or at any merchant locations where they electronically convert your paper check.

Ex: You need to pay your cellular bill for the month and its due today!! You log into Verizon's website and schedule a payment to Verizon using your routing number and account number, you select the payment date of today. The payment to Verizon comes out the same day you schedule it and it overdraws your account because you don't get paid until tomorrow-previously the earliest the payment could have come out would have been tomorrow-Effective Sept. 15, 2017.
